

## MCAA Draft Rules for Winter Basketball

### Evaluations

- Players will demonstrate their basketball ability based on pre-defined categories defined by the league director. Height will be verified. Coaches will rate each player from 1 to 5 in each category. The rating scale is as follows:

1. No skill
2. Little skill
3. Average skill
4. Good skill
5. Excellent skill

In the event that more than one child has the same overall score, we will base the final ranking on years of experience first, then height second

Coaches will turn in their rankings to the league director after the try-outs and his/her scores will be copied and the original returned

### Player Rankings

- Each player's scores will be averaged and a master list will be generated. The master list will have all the players ranked from highest to lowest.
- The master list will be distributed before the draft, giving coaches an accurate ranking of each player. The master list will also assist in the evaluation of the coach's children.

### Coach's Children

- Coaches are automatically assigned to their child. The overall rankings will determine what round the child is placed in.
- The coach's child is assigned to the coach before the draft begins
- Coaches will not draft another player in the round his/her child is selected.

### Unrated Players

- Any player that did not attend try-outs will be given a rating by a majority vote from the coaches before the draft begins.
- Any player that cannot be accurately evaluated by the coaches, will be considered a 'hat pick'.

### Draft Day

- Each coach will randomly draw a number. That number will represent the Coach's draft order

- The draft order will begin with the #1 and continue down to the last coach. The second round will begin with the last coach and continue in numerical order back up to #1. Therefore, the last coach will have two consecutive picks, on the transition from the odd round to an even round
- Coaches cannot reserve an assistant coach's or team moms or any other child. He/She must be drafted. Coaches can state their desire to select someone in future rounds, however, the other coaches do not have to honor this request.
- Coaches will have one (1) minute to make a selection. If the time limit is exceeded, the League Director/Board Member in charge of the draft can automatically assign the highest rated player available to that coach's team.
- Siblings are automatically assigned to the same team. Once the first of two siblings is drafted, the second child is assigned to the same coach as that coach's pick in the round where the second sibling was rated.
- A player must be ranked within one round of the current round to be eligible for selection. (i.e. players ranked between rounds 1 & 2 can be selected in the first round.)
- Once all players have been selected, the hat picks are assigned a team. The next coach to draft will randomly draw a hat pick player.
- TRADES: Trades are at the discretion of the league director and all trades must be made within 10 minutes of the draft ending. Both players must be ranked within one round for a trade to be approved. All trades must be approved by a majority vote of all coaches in the league.
- At the end of the draft, all teams will be considered final selections and cannot be changed without the approval of the basketball board

#### Teams with Additional Player

- If necessary, Coaches will be asked to volunteer to carry an additional player. If enough coaches do not volunteer; coaches will be randomly selected from the hat.
- The coaches with an additional player will receive two draft selections in the last round.
